Dear Mr. Wendtland:

Enclosed are two Ten-Day Notices (TDN's) we have prepared about the ongoing situation regarding the self-bonding of Alpha Natural Resources, Inc. and Alpha Coal West, Inc. (hereinafter referred to as Alpha) mines in Wyoming.

The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE) has been in contact with WYDEQ since your office ordered Alpha to obtain a replacement bond of approximately \$411 million on May 26, 2015, for the Belle Ayr Mine (Self-Bond No. SBC 128 for Permit No. 214) and the Eagle Butte Mine (Self-Bond No. SBC 131 for Permit No. 428). Several significant events occurred after WYDEQ issued the bond replacement order. Alpha challenged WYDEQ's findings in State District Court and shortly thereafter filed for Chapter 11 bankruptcy protection in Federal Bankruptcy Court. WYDEQ and Alpha entered into a voluntary agreement (hereinafter referred to as Stipulation) under which WYDEQ would gain a \$61 million "Superpriority" claim in case of liquidation in exchange for WYDEQ's promise to stay any enforcement action regarding self-bonding until reorganization of Alpha's debts could be finalized. The Bankruptcy Court approved the Stipulation and WYDEQ and Alpha filed a joint notice of the Stipulation with the State Court. OSMRE has filed a notice with the Court reserving its right to engage in regulatory enforcement. Both the Belle Ayr and Eagle Butte mines remain operational and no replacement bonds have been obtained.

Given the information above and that provided in the enclosed narrative, the fact that Alpha has not filed a replacement bond or collateral of any sort, and the fact that Alpha continues to extract coal, OSMRE has reason to believe a violation of the Wyoming Approved State program may exist. Specifically, OSMRE has reason to believe Alpha coal may be in violation of Wyoming

Land Quality Division Coal Rules and Regulations found at Chapter 12, Section 2 (b) (Bonding and Insurance Procedures) because it may have allowed the bond amount to fall below the amount necessary to assure that the operator will faithfully perform all requirements of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act and will comply with all rules and regulations and any provisions of the approved permit.

Please respond as directed in 30 CFR 842.11 within ten business days by taking appropriate action to cause the possible violation to be corrected or to show good cause for such failure. Appropriate action and good cause are explained in 30 CFR 842.11(b)(3) and (4). Good cause includes showing that the possible violation does not exist under the approved State program. This TDN does not constitute a written determination under 30 CFR 842.11(b)(1)(ii)(B)(1) of whether the standards for appropriate action or good cause have been met, and does not constitute a notice of violation or cessation order under 30 CFR Part 843. After WYDEQ's response, OSMRE will issue its written determination and, if necessary, will issue any necessary order to correct the violation, if found.

As a result of the information below, the Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE) has reason to believe that the Wyoming Department of Environmental Quality-Land Quality Division (WYDEQ) may have allowed Alpha Natural Resources, Inc. and Alpha Coal West, Inc. (collectively, Alpha), to operate in violation of the Wyoming Approved State Program. Therefore, pursuant to 30 U.S.C. § 1271(a) and 30 C.F.R., § 842.11(b)(1)(ii)(B)(I), OSMRE is issuing the following Ten Day Notices (TDN's):

TDN #X16-010-549-008 – Permit # 214-T7 (Belle Ayr Mine)

TDN #X16-010-549-008 – Permit # 428-T6 (Eagle Butte Mine)

The Federal regulation at 30 C.F.R. § 842.11 provides that absent an imminent danger or harm scenario, OSMRE must issue a TDN to a Regulatory Authority (RA) when it has reason to believe a violation exists or when, on the basis of a Federal inspection, it determines that a violation exists (and OSMRE has not issued a previous TDN for the same violation). These TDN's are not based on Federal inspections, and OSMRE has not yet determined that a violation exists. However, on the basis of the information summarized below, OSMRE has reason to believe that WYDEQ may be allowing Alpha to operate in violation of the Wyoming Environmental Quality Act (Wyoming Act) and WYDEQ Coal Rules and Regulations by allowing the reclamation bond amount for Alpha's Wyoming surface mining operations to fall below the amount necessary to assure that the operator will faithfully perform all requirements of the Wyoming Act and comply with all rules and regulations and any provisions of the approved permit.

In accordance with the Wyoming Act and WYDEQ Rules and Regulations for Coal, surface mine operators may "self-bond" to cover the costs of reclaiming mine sites if the requisite criteria are satisfied. *See* Wyo. Stat. § 35-11-417(d); Wyo. Admin. Code § ENV LQC Ch. 11 § 2(a)(vii)(A)-(C). Since 2010, Alpha has self-bonded its operations in Wyoming at the Eagle Butte Mine (Permit #428-T6) and the Belle Ayr Mine (Permit #214-T8). Alpha self-bonded those operations through, respectively, self-bond agreements SBC 131 and SBC 0128. By two Coal Self-Bond Indemnity Agreements executed concurrently, Alpha Coal West, Inc. agreed to indemnify OSMRE and WYDEQ for its obligations under the self-bond agreements. In turn, Alpha Natural Resources guaranteed Alpha Coal West's obligations under the self-bond agreements by two Coal Self-Bond Corporate Guarantees.

When Alpha first executed the self-bond, indemnity, and cooperate guarantee agreements in March 2010, the bond amount for the Eagle Butte Mine was \$123,375,000.00 and the bond amount for the Belle Ayr Mine was \$123,899,000.00. By October 2014, the bond amount for the Eagle Butte Mine had increased to \$203,006,000.00; and to \$208,258,000.00 for the Belle Ayr Mine. Those amounts, totaling over \$411 million, represented the amount necessary to meet all requirements of the Wyoming Act and to comply with all rules and regulations and any provisions of the approved permit in the event that Alpha could not faithfully do so. *See* Wyo. Stat. § 35-11-417(a).

On April 20, 2015, WYDEQ notified Alpha Natural Resources that the financial information submitted for year end 2014 indicated that the company may not meet the corporate guarantor requirements under the WYDEQ regulations. After allowing a response, WYDEQ determined on

May 26, 2015, that Alpha no longer qualified under the WYDEQ self-bonding program and that Alpha's self-bonds failed to provide the protection consistent with the objectives and purposes of the Wyoming Act and WYDEQ Rules and Regulations for Coal. Accordingly, WYDEQ determined that, among other matters, Alpha's right to self-bond would terminate by August 24, 2015, and that Alpha was required by that date to post a reclamation bond or substitute collateral of approximately \$411 million<sup>1</sup> in order to be allowed to continue its surface coal mining operations in Wyoming.

Alpha did not post a reclamation bond or substitute collateral by the August 24, 2015 deadline. Instead, Alpha challenged the WYDEQ's substitution demand administratively on June 24, 2015, in the Sixth Judicial District Court of Campbell County, Wyoming (Civ. Action No. 35558). On July 24, 2015, the WYDEQ concurred with Alpha's request for a stay of the bond substitution deadline pending further administrative process. On July 29, 2015, the Wyoming Court granted that request and imposed a stay until the conclusion of an informal review process by the WYDEQ.

WYDEQ did not conduct the final informal review process that formed the basis of the State District Court's stay. On August 3, 2015, Alpha and certain affiliates filed voluntary petitions for relief under Chapter 11 of the United States Bankruptcy Code in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Virginia (jointly administered in Case No. 15-33896). On September 29, 2015, Alpha moved the Bankruptcy Court to enter an order approving a "Stipulation and Order Concerning Debtor's Reclamation Bonding of Their Surface Coal Mining Operations in Wyoming" (Stipulation).

Under the Stipulation, WYDEQ agreed that Alpha could "satisfy the bonding requirements for their reclamation obligations without complying with the Wyoming Substitution Demand." Stipulation ¶ 1. WYDEQ agreed it would "not seek additional collateral or revoke, terminate, refuse to grant or amend or take any other adverse action with respect to the [Alpha's] mining permits or licenses on account of [Alpha's] failure to comply with the Wyoming Substitution Demand or reclamation bonding obligations." *Id.* ¶ 2. WYDEQ further agreed to "not seek to enforce the Indemnity Agreements or Guarantees or seek to revoke, terminate, refuse to grant or amend or take any other adverse action with respect to the Debtors' mining permits or licenses on account of the Debtors' non-payment of obligations under the Indemnity Agreements or Guarantees." *Id.* Further, WYDEQ agreed that "any proceedings relating to the Wyoming Substitution Demand or the [Alpha's] self-bonding status, including the informal review process of WYDEQ, shall be stayed." *Id.*

Thus, the Stipulation allows for Alpha to continue coal extraction activities at its Wyoming mines for a "Compliance Plan Period"<sup>2</sup> without posting alternative bonds in the full amount of

the estimated \$411 million of bond liability. Instead, the WYDEQ would receive only a superpriority status claim of \$61 million over and above administrative expenses, from a "Bonding Carve-Out" provided by the debtor in possession credit agreement entered August 6, 2015. See Stipulation ¶ 1.

In response to Alpha's motion, OMSRE filed a notice with the Bankruptcy Court reserving, among other matters, its rights to regulatory enforcement. The Bankruptcy Court approved Alpha's motion and the stipulation by order of October 8, 2015. Alpha and WYDEQ subsequently filed a Joint Notice of Bankruptcy Stay with State District Court.

In light of the information summarized above, OSMRE has reason to believe that a violation of the approved state program may exist because WYDEQ may be allowing Alpha to operate in violation of the Wyoming Act and WYDEQ Coal Rules and Regulations, Chapter 12, Section 2(b) (Bonding and Insurance Procedures) by allowing the bond amount to fall below the amount necessary to assure that the operator will faithfully perform all requirements of the Wyoming Act and will comply with all rules and regulations and any provisions of the approved permit.

The Wyoming Act's reclamation bonding provisions requirements include:

(a) The purpose of any bond required to be filed with the administrator by the operator shall be to assure that the operator shall faithfully perform all requirements of this act and comply with all rules and regulations of the board made in accordance with the provisions of this act.

\* \* \* \*

(c) The amount of any bond to be filed with the administrator prior to commencing any mining shall be:

\* \* \* \*

(ii) For renewal bonds the amount equal to the estimated cost of reclaiming the land to be disturbed during that renewal period, and the estimated cost of completing reclamation of unreleased lands and groundwater disturbed during prior periods of time. The estimated cost shall be based on the operator's cost estimate, which shall include any changes in the actual or estimated cost of reclamation of unreleased affected lands, plus the administrator's estimate of the additional cost to the state of bringing in personnel and equipment should the operator fail or the site be abandoned. In no event shall the bond be less than ten thousand dollars (\$10,000.00), except for sand and gravel, pumice, scoria or jade mining or any mine, except surface coal mines, the affected land of which, excluding roads, is ten (10) acres or less, in which case the bond amount shall be

set by the administrator with approval of the director to cover the cost of reclamation, and in no event less than two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per acre, for affected land.

Wyo. Stat. § 35-11-417 (Bonding Provisions).

WYDEQ Coal Rules and Regulations implementing the Wyoming Act's bonding provisions specify:

For purposes of determining bond amounts, the estimated cost shall include all costs necessary, expedient or incidental to achieve required rough backfilling and reclamation. This shall reflect the probable difficulty of reclaiming the affected lands, giving consideration, as applicable, to such factors as topography, geology of the site, hydrology and revegetation potential. The estimated cost shall be based on the operator's cost estimate submitted with the permit, plus the Administrator's estimate of the additional cost to the State of bringing in personnel and equipment should the operation fail or the site be abandoned, plus an additional amount covering reclamation cost for any land which may reasonably be expected to be affected, as determined by the Administrator's assessment of the applicant's mine plan, prior to filing the renewal bond. *All bonds shall be calculated on, and never fall below, the amount necessary to assure that the operator shall faithfully perform all requirements of the [Wyoming] Act to comply with all rules and regulations and any provisions of the approved permit.*

Wyo. Admin. Code § ENV LQC Ch. 12 § 2(b) (Bonding and Insurance Procedures) (emphasis added).

As noted, on June 15, 2015, WYDEQ determined in accordance with the Wyoming Act, Section 35-11-411(d),<sup>3</sup> that the bond for the Eagle Butte Mine (Permit #428-T6) be set at \$191,370,000.00; and the bond for the Belle Ayr Mine (Permit #214-T8) be set at \$218,907,000.00. These two amounts, totaling \$410,277,000.00, represent the amount necessary to perform all requirements of the Wyoming Act and to comply with all rules and regulations and any provisions of the approved permit in the event that Alpha could not faithfully do so.

In May 2015, WYDEQ determined that Alpha no longer qualified under the WYDEQ self-bonding program and that Alpha's self-bonds failed to provide the protection consistent with the objectives and purposes of the Approved State Program. Accordingly, WYDEQ issued a demand to Alpha that, among other matters, it post reclamation bonds or substitute collateral of approximately \$411 million by August 24, 2015, to be allowed to continue its surface coal mining operations in Wyoming. Based on available information, OSMRE understands that the facts supporting WDEQ's determination of Alpha's ineligibility under the WDEQ's self-bonding program have not changed.

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<sup>3</sup> Based on an inspection reports, an annual report of proposed mining and reclamation progress, and other required materials, the WYDEQ shall determine the size of the bond to be posted for the purpose of insuring reclamation of the lands affected during the ensuing year.

Based on the information detailed above, OSMRE also understands that Alpha, with WDEQ's assent, has still not posted reclamation bonds or any collateral acceptable under the Wyoming Act and WDEQ Regulations and Rules for the Eagle Butte and Belle Ayr Mines. Yet, Alpha continues coal extraction activities at the mines. Therefore, OSMRE has reason to believe that WYDEQ may be allowing Alpha to operate in violation of the Wyoming Act, Section 35-11-417 (Bonding Provisions), and WYDEQ Coal Rules and Regulation, Chapter 12, Section 2(b) (Bonding and Insurance Procedures).

Therefore, OSMRE is issuing the following TDN's:

TDN #X16-010-549-008 – Permit # 214-T7 (Belle Ayr Mine)

TDN #X16-010-549-008 – Permit # 428-T6 (Eagle Butte Mine)

WYDEQ may respond to these notices as directed in 30 CFR 842.11 within ten business days by taking appropriate action to cause the possible violation to be corrected, or to show good cause for such failure. Appropriate action and good cause are defined 30 CFR 842.11(b)(3) and (4). Good cause includes showing that the possible violation does not exist under the approved State program. These TDN's do not constitute written determinations under 30 CFR 842.11(b)(1)(ii)(B)(I) of whether the standards for appropriate action or good cause have been met, and do not constitute notices of violation or cessation orders under 30 CFR Part 843. After WYDEQ's response, OSMRE will issue its written determination and, if necessary, will issue any necessary order to correct the violation, if found.




